Availability of Draft Environmental Impact Statement

Environmental Impact Statement

The Surface Transportation Board's (Board) Office of Environmental Analysis (OEA) is pleased to announce that the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (Draft EIS) for Green Eagle Railroad's proposed construction and operation of a 1.3-mile rail line in Eagle Pass and Maverick County, Texas, is available for review and comment. The proposed line is part of the larger Puerto Verde Global Trade Bridge project that also includes a new commercial motor vehicle (CMV) crossing between Piedras Negras, Coahuila, Mexico, and Eagle Pass, Texas. The Draft EIS analyzes the potential environmental impacts of both the proposed rail line, which requires a license from the Board, and the CMV crossing because they would be built as a single port of entry for freight rail and CMV traffic between Mexico and the United States.
